*Approval of Minutes for the August 27, 2013 Meeting

Joan noted a correction. She was absent at the August 27, 2013 meeting.

Heather motioned to approve the minutes as corrected. Ammon seconded the motion.

The amended minutes were approved unanimously.

*School Performance Framework & Review of Growth Model

Tori started this discussion by showing the growth video on the Alpine Achievement website. Time for discussion followed.

Burlington SPF Review –

Tori walked the members through each piece of the data showing on the report. .

Longmont High School SPF Review –

The high school data has an added component, Postsecondary and Workforce Readiness. This data encompasses ACT scores and graduation rates.

The SPF is a complex, data filled document. It takes time to understand each piece. Administrators often ask how best to break the data down for parents. The Assessment team is available to principals to go over their reports so that they may better understand them.

Josie is sharing what she learns regarding the data with the Latino Parent Advisory Council.

*School Performance Framework Summary Data & Accreditation Ratings

Two documents were shared. One document compares the 2012 and 2013 data. The other shows the Achievement, Growth, Growth Gaps and Post Secondary Workforce Readiness scores.

The color coded documents show that the majority of the SVVSD schools have performance indicators at the Performance level. Northridge Elementary is on Priority Improvement for the first time this year. Alternative school data is not available until later this fall.

The data for Thunder Valley will carry over from the Frederick Elementary data as Thunder Valley is not recognized as a new school by CDE definition.

Timberline PK-8 is recognized as a new school by CDE and does not have reporting data.

Heather August made a motion to vote to accredit schools based on the SPF data.

Joan Martin seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The accreditation for the alternative school accreditation will take place after data is received and reviewed.

*Senate Bill 191 Evaluation Plan Presentation

Discussion around how teachers can help. This is a pilot year, a year held harmless. The evaluation format the District chose allows all teachers in the building to work together for success.

*October School Visits

Two dates were chosen for the October school visits. First choice is October 16, with the second choice of October 24. Tori will verify with principals which date works best for them.

Skyline, Thunder Valley, Northridge and Indian Peaks will be the schools the team will visit.
