



Healthy Kids Make Great Students!

Our Family Outreach Liaisons can help eligible children and families apply for Health First Colorado (Colorado’s Medicaid Program), Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+), and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).

Health First Colorado and CHP+ are free or low-cost health insurance plans with no monthly premiums. Benefits include well-child and doctor visits, sports physicals, immunizations, prescriptions, hospital services, mental/behavioral health, prenatal care, and dental and vision care.

SNAP (formerly known as food stamps) is a monthly benefit that can be used like a debit card at local retailers to buy a variety of food items.
