

# SECONDARY SUMMER SCHOOL LONGMONT HIGH 2017



**COURSES:** Students can *ONLY* enroll in a course that has been previously taken and failed during the regular school year. Courses will be offered if enrollment reaches a minimum number of students. ***This is a traditional summer school experience offered at Longmont High, and is not online.***

**COURSES OFFERED:** Geometry A/B, Algebra 1A/B, Algebra 2A/B, World Geography A/B, US History A/B, US Government A/B, English 9A/B, English 10A/B, English 11 A/B, Biology A/B

**There are three ways to register for Summer School:**

**Counselor Registration:** Please pre-register with the school counselor at your high school. Your counselor can review your transcripts and help you to register for the correct classes. Make checks out to SVVSD.

**Online Registration:** Go to [stvrain.revtrak.net](http://stvrain.revtrak.net). Choose High School, and then Summer School. It will be available until May 31<sup>st</sup>.

**Registration Night:** A final chance to register will be at the Registration Night held on Thursday, June 1<sup>st</sup> from 6:00-8:00pm at Longmont High.

**All students registering on this night will need to make at least a down payment of \$75 for each semester they enroll.**

**ATTENDANCE POLICY:** There are no excused absences or tardies during the Summer School session. Students must make a commitment to be on time to class and be in attendance every day. Students not in class at the starting time will be marked tardy. Students arriving more than 20 minutes late will be marked absent. Three tardies equals one absence. Parents will be contacted for each absence. A student will be dropped from the summer school session on the third accumulated absence without a refund of tuition fees, and parents will be notified.
