



## **2014-2015 Tax Work-Off Program**

If selected to participate in the Tax Work-Off Program, there are several things you should know:

- Most volunteer opportunities are in our schools during school hours working with students.
  - Although we try to accommodate requests for specific duties and schools, our number one priority is to support those teachers who request volunteer assistance.
  - Most teachers ask that volunteers work 1-3 hours per day, 2-3 days per week. Please don't expect to complete your hours in a week or two.
  - You must complete your volunteer hours for this program by the end of April.
  - You will be working under the direction of a teacher or other staff member. They will advise you of any rules or requirements specific to the individual school and will tell you how to keep track of your hours.
  - Background checks will be done on all applicants. You will be paid for a maximum of 40 hours at \$8.00 per hour for a total of \$320.00. You may work fewer hours and you will be paid accordingly.
  - Your check will be made out to you for your use in paying your property taxes to your county of residence.
  - We appreciate our volunteers! If you'd like to continue volunteering without compensation after completing your 40 hours, let your teacher know or contact Linda Lohmann for another assignment.
  - All participants in the Tax Work-Off Program must be reinstated each year. Watch for information in the local newspapers and on our website, [www.svvsd.org](http://www.svvsd.org). Registration for the 2014-2015 school year will be between November 3 and November 14, 2014; work must be completed between January and April 2015.
