The students presented a video they produced about Lyons M/S and

Lyons Elementary and handed out framed pictures of the video title to the Board. Board members felt the students really captured the uniqueness of Lyons in the video, and suggested they show the video to the Lyons Town Council and Chamber of Commerce.

ACTION ITEMS (7.0)

Adoption of Amended Budget FY 2014-2015 (7.1)

Paula Peairs moved that the Board of Education adopt the amended budget for fiscal year 2014-2015 as presented. Debbie Lammers seconded.

Tony Whiteley reported that Colorado Revised Statute 22-44-110(5) allows the Board of Education to review and change the budget with respect to both revenues and expenditures, at any time prior to January 31 of the fiscal year for which the budget was adopted.

The FY 2015 Superintendent's Proposed Budget was introduced at the May 28, 2014 Board Meeting, including questions and discussion. On June 11, 2014, the Proposed Budget was available to the public for questions. On June 11, 2014, the Board adopted

the FY 2015 Superintendent's Budget. Since that date, there have been some expected revisions and new information that Tony presented to the Board.

Approval of Amended Intergovernmental Agreement with EAGLE-Net Alliance (7.2)

John Creighton moved that the Board of Education approve the proposed changes to the EAGLE-Net Alliance Intergovernmental Agreement. Paula Peairs seconded.

Terry Schueler reported that the District purchases high-speed broadband services as a member of the EAGLE-Net Alliance. The Intergovernmental Agreement creating and maintaining this entity is proposed for modification as EAGLE-Net grows and expands its service area. The existing IGA requires 100% approval of IGA members of any amendments. District staff is in favor of the proposed amendments which provide flexibility and growth opportunity to the EAGLE-Net Alliance.

Approval of Extension of Superintendent Contract (7.3)

Mike Schiers moved that the Board of Education approve a one-year extension to Dr. Haddad's contract and for the Board to obtain a salary survey to bring his base salary in line with other districts of similar enrollment and size. Joie Siegrist seconded.

The Board would like to grant a one-year extension to Dr. Haddad's current Employment Agreement from June 30, 2018 to June 30, 2019, and authorize the Board to obtain a salary survey and to make a recommendation to the Board at a later date regarding a further amendment to the Employment Agreement to bring the base salary in line with other districts of similar enrollment and size and to recognize Dr. Haddad's performance over the past year.

Since it will take time to complete the salary survey, the written addendum will be completed after the survey and brought before the Board at a later date.

Joie Siegrist moved that the Board of Education authorize administration to finalize negotiations with the City of Longmont regarding a Right of Entry at the Burlington Elementary School property indicated on attached Exhibit A to accommodate the construction of the flood damaged wading pool at the City owned Kanemoto Park. John Creighton seconded.

Brian Lamer reported that the City of Longmont asked the District for access of a small section of unused property south of the Burlington Elementary play fields that abuts Kanemoto Park. To keep the pool renovation on schedule, the City asked for temporary access until the final documents can be developed and presented to the Board of Education in March. Construction of the pool will begin in February of 2015. Final documents were reviewed by District legal counsel.
