Overview of Gifted Programming Options	<p>*All gifted students get ALP's that are reviewed several times a year by the GT site leader and classroom teachers.</p> <p>*Students are invited to participate in district wide events, including Shakespeare and Equations.</p> <p>*Students have the opportunity to participate in before or after school enrichment modules.</p>
Enrichment Options	<p>Legacy has an enrichment coordinator that provides enrichment classes to all students in the school. These classes are held before or after school and may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Coding *Literature studies *Chess *Critical thinking
Social/Emotional Support	Legacy has a school counselor, Leena Figall. GT students are provided the opportunity to participate in a module focused on social/emotional needs. The school, as a whole, provides for individual needs of students through the council department and social/emotional curriculum.
Classroom Differentiation and Extensions	<p>Classroom teachers differentiate instruction daily for all students. This includes flexible grouping where appropriate.</p> <p>Subject area acceleration and grade level acceleration.</p> <p>Content extensions are provided for individual students by teachers as needed. The GT site leader provides support and resources to teachers when necessary.</p>
