

## P-TEACH CU Denver Course Consent Form, Fall 2019

The School of Education and Human Development at CU Denver has partnered with the St. Vrain School District to offer education courses in the P-TEACH program. P-TEACH courses provide high school students the opportunity to take college courses in high school to earn both high school and college credit. These courses have been developed and reviewed by CU Denver faculty and are equivalent in regard to content and academic standards to those courses taught on the CU Denver campus. The instructors for the P-TEACH education courses have also met the same standards as on-campus instructors and have been granted adjunct faculty status by the School of Education and Human Development at CU Denver.

Credits earned through the CU Denver P-TEACH courses will appear on an official University of Colorado Denver transcript and can be applied to the undergraduate teaching programs in the School of Education and Human Development at CU Denver. College level courses are rigorous and demand time and effort, so it is important that you consider both the pros and cons of taking university-level work as grades from these courses will be reflected in a college-level GPA. These courses may also transfer into other four year and twoyear colleges, but that is not guaranteed.
