Focus (if applicable)	Students will use self-advocacy to communicate their needs regarding differentiation to increase engagement and decrease underachievement.
Overview of Gifted Programming Options	Flexible ability grouping, cohort cluster grouping, curriculum compacting, affective needs counseling group
Enrichment Options	Modules-before or after school classes offered for free to GT students. In the past we have offered astronomy, creative writing, kitchen chemistry, paper mache, science experiments, making travel brochures, etc.
Social/Emotional Support	Counselor support groups for emotional needs, social skills, self-regulation and self-advocacy.
Classroom Differentiation and Extensions	Choice based assignments, compacting, learning contracts, menus, most difficult problems first, problem-based learning, tiered assignments, varying levels of depth, complexity, pacing, cognitive skills, pre-assessment, adjust curriculum pacing, grouping. In Focus curriculum, Self-Advocacy counseling groups, Student Council, after school modules, Equations, independent projects. Early access, content acceleration, whole grade acceleration.
