

# Stormwater Concern or Illicit Discharge

## Public Report

*The following information is intended as a guide to help identify and respond to a concern or a report of an illicit discharge regarding the District's stormwater sewer system.*

In the event of a concern or a spill or release of material into the storm sewer (other than normal stormwater or precipitation run-off):

- Identify location of affected drain (be descriptive as possible – drain in NW corner of Frances Street and 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Longmont)

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- Identify affected municipality or receiving waters (such as canal or creek name).

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- Report Concern or suspected spills or releases to Environmental Compliance Coordinator at 303-702-7527 or email at [hronich\\_gregory@svvsd.org](mailto:hronich_gregory@svvsd.org).

- Identify material spilled or discharged: \_\_\_\_\_
