On February 22, 2012, the Board of Education approved the conceptual plan to move forward developing a pre-school through 8th grade (P8) school in the Longmont City limits. Spangler Elementary, Loma Linda Elementary and Heritage Middle School were identified and plans to reconfigure the facility to accommodate the program began. The new Longmont P8 school will embrace Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) opportunities as well as a continued International Baccalaureate (IB) focus. Grounded in the rigors of educational excellence the school is planned to open in August 2013.
