

## **Temporary Administrative Assignments**

In the temporary absence or inability of the superintendent, the superintendent may delegate his or her powers and duties by directive. In the absence of a specific directive from the superintendent, an assistant superintendent shall act as superintendent.

In the case of absence or inability of the superintendent and an assistant superintendent, the chief financial officer shall act as the superintendent temporarily until such time as the Board can convene and appoint an acting superintendent.
