Walkers and Riders

Elementary students, including those attending a K-8 or PK-8 school, who live more than one and one-half miles and secondary students who live more than two and one-half miles from the school in their home attendance area may ride from a specified pick-up point established by the department of transportation to the school facility in their attendance area.

Elementary students living less than one and one-half miles and secondary students living less than two and one-half miles from the school in their home attendance area may apply for and receive space-available transportation from an established public pick-up point providing there is space on the bus.

Half-day kindergarten students may ride one way within these limitations. If attending the morning session, they may ride to school. If attending the afternoon session, they may ride home. Full-day kindergarten students are eligible for transportation both to and from school.

Exceptions may be made in cases where hazardous crossing or other safety factors compel consideration. In such cases, the supervisor of transportation shall make a study of the factors involved and recommend specific action to the Board.

Any exception to the above to meet applicable legal requirements shall require approval of the superintendent or designee.
