

## Early Graduation

The Board of Education recognizes the value of a full high school program and emphasizes its dedication to the encouragement of academic excellence. Therefore, the Board shall consider early graduation for students who have completed graduation requirements prior to the end of their senior year and desire to discontinue high school course work only if they meet the following criteria:

1. Accrual of credits required by the Board for graduation
2. No grades below a C
3. Personal considerations which in the judgment of the high school principal and the superintendent or designee are compelling

Following graduation, a student is no longer eligible to enroll in district courses including postsecondary option courses.
