

School Districting/Redistricting

It is understood that the superintendent will need to make recommendations to the Board of Education to redistrict school attendance boundaries when certain conditions exist.

The following conditions would warrant a change in school attendance boundaries:

1. A new school is constructed;
2. When the use of a school is to be discontinued;
3. A great disparity exists among schools in their enrollments in relationship to their capacities;
4. When large scale developments are proposed which would create great disparity in enrollment.
