Determination of a Student's School Attendance Area

- 1. The physical residence of the student within the district will determine the student's designated attendance area. For the purpose of this regulation, residence means the student resides with his/her legal guardian.
- 2. Submitting a "Power of Attorney" form transferring responsibility for a child to another adult does not change the student's address/attendance area in determining school of attendance.
- 3. Documentation is necessary to prove residency for any student. Examples:
 - utility/telephone bill
 - contract to build/purchase house
 - voter registration card
 - emancipated student
 - homeless student as verified by student services
 - student driver's license
- 4. Principals are expected to verify information received through:
 - · home visits by school staff
 - informal information received
 - periodic verification
- 5. Appeal procedure

Should a request for attendance to a school be denied based on a determination that the student does not reside within the attendance area, the parent/guardian will be advised by the principal of the open enrollment and appeal procedures.
