This plan documents academic goals, classroom strategies, social emotional goals, and progress monitoring. Social Emotional Support	Identified students in third - fifth grade come to the Gifted & Talented classroom an additional time each week for Social-Emotional support. During that time we work on teamwork, self advocacy, and other social emotional needs through working through using Project-Based Learning Lessons That Build Critical Thinking, Emotional Intelligence, and Social Skills by Mark Hess.
School Focus	Erie Elementary is a <u>STEM focus</u> school. All classroom teachers incorporate standards based, engaging STEM activities throughout the day. In addition, students attend 45 minutes of a STEM lab weekly.
