Overview of Gifted and Talented	At Frederick High School, students identified as gifted and talented create a personalized Advance Learning Plan each school year. They meet with the GT site leader to monitor progress on their plan throughout the year. The GT program at FHS is one of the most robust in the state and includes: Gifted and talented seminar course available for all grades, Honors programs, College campus visits, AP/Concurrent enrollment, CU Gold courses, one-on-one meeting with GT liaison, group GT meetings each quarter, guest speakers, college/ career planning as well as a specialized GT counselor who is always available and sends monthly updates and reminders.
