<b>Overview of Gifted and Talented</b>	According to the Colorado Department of Education: “Gifted children” means those persons between the ages of five and twenty-one whose abilities, talents, and potential for accomplishment are so outstanding that they require special provisions to meet their educational needs. Gifted students include gifted students with disabilities (i.e. twice exceptional) and students with exceptional abilities or potential from all socio-economic and ethnic, cultural populations.
<b>Programming and Enrichment Opportunities</b>	<p>Grand View provides many additional enrichment opportunities before and after school, including Robotics, National Novel Writing Month Club, Art Club, 100 Mile Running Club, Bison Choral Music Club, Student Council.</p> <p>Grand View Elementary offers a wide range of services to meet the needs of our Gifted students. All gifted students will have an Advanced Learning Plan (ALP) that addresses goals and programming for their specific areas of giftedness. These goals are developed by their teacher and the GT coordinator, with input from the parents and the student. Plans include classroom strategies such as choice-based assignments, grouping with academic peers, problem-based learning, depth and complexity tools, learning contracts, tiered assignments, and compacting.</p>
