Overview of Gifted and Talented	At Mead Middle School, students complete their ALP's with the site leader and then work with their classroom teacher in their subject area to complete their goals of projects or differentiated instruction. Students have the opportunity to work with the GT site leader during advisory on a passion project of their choice. The projects are based upon their subject area but include an additional interest of the students. Students create bog questions and collect research to try and answer their questions. Students build a digital presentation that they share and present with the GT advisory class. Students join a GT book study with the site leader during advisory.
