Overview of Gifted and Talented	Rocky Mountain Elementary offers a wide range of services to meet the needs of our gifted students. Teachers use differentiation to meet the needs of gifted students in their classrooms. Teachers are trained in using depth and complexity and flexible grouping options. Students can also be grade or content accelerated to meet their diverse needs as appropriate. Gifted students are grouped with similar-ability peers to allow for small group instruction inside the classroom. Students who are identified receive an Advanced Learning Plan (ALP) that is created in the fall. The ALP is created with collaboration between parents and teachers and includes academic and affective goals for the year.
Programming and Enrichment Opportunities	Rocky Mountain offers enrichment opportunities before and after school. Some opportunities include Robotics, Thorne Nature Experience, and 100 Mile Club.
Social Emotional Support	All students at Rocky Mountain participate in our school wide Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) program. Teachers use the In Focus curriculum to help students develop social and emotional intelligence.
School Focus	At Rocky Mountain we are a STEM school, all students visit our iRock Zone (maker space) weekly to complete design challenges and teachers incorporate STEM into their classroom instruction. We are also a biliteracy school and recognize the value of cultural and linguistic diversity.
