Programming and Enrichment Opportunities	Skyline High School participates in the College Board's National Advanced Placement (AP) program with 23 weighted-grade course options, as well as P-TECH, Visual and Performing arts courses, and STEM classes.Skyline High School also provides a variety of <u>co-curricular activities</u> for students with diverse interests and talents.	
Social Emotional Support	<u>Guidance and counseling</u> services are provided for the purpose of assisting students with their educational, vocational, personal-social adjustments, and progress.	
School Focus	Skyline High School is the flagship IBM P-TECH school in the western United States. In collaboration with IBM and Front Range Community College, P-TECH students earn a no-cost Associate of Applied Science Degree alongside their high school diploma. Skyline's STEM Academy offers a wide-variety of topics including robotics, biomechanics, renewable energy, engineering, and computer science. The Visual and Performing Arts Academy (VPA) offers classes in visual arts, music, drama, dance, and students receive a VPA Certificate upon completion of a Capstone project.
