Overview of Gifted and Talented	St.Vrain Virtual High School students who are identified as gifted and talented create a personalized advanced learning plan each school year. They meet with the GT site leader to monitor progress on their plan throughout the year. The GT site leader serves as a mentor allowing for daily check-ins with students and weekly check-ins with families.
Programming and Enrichment Opportunities	St. Vrain Virtual High School offers students 15 <u>Advanced Placement</u> weighted grade courses. There are also 20 <u>Honors</u> weighted grade courses as well as <u>Concurrent Enrollment</u> opportunities with Front Range Community College, Aims Community College, and the University of Colorado Boulder. Interest clubs and <u>co-curricular activities</u> (such as art and creative writing) are offered weekly. SVVHS also offers a variety of <u>options for students in the</u> <u>visual and performing arts</u> .
Social Emotional Support	We have a <u>full time counselor and a full time engagement specialist</u> , and a half-time interventionist next year. We offer CommUNITY of Strength classes at 4 different times each week. We also have weekly grade level meetings and a stress management group.
School Focus	The district's virtual high school utilizes high-quality instruction and curriculum provided by <u>FLVS Global School</u> . Flexibility to choose when and where to learn affords students with the opportunity to complete school daily at a time of their choice.
