Overview of Gifted and Talented	At Westview Middle School, students that have been identified as gifted and talented create a personalized advanced learning plan each school year. They meet with the GT site leader to monitor progress on their plan throughout the year. Every class differentiates instruction to meet students where they are in their learning. Every grade level provides leveled math classes. Students can also access Core-X, where students receive extra math instruction. Four times a week we offer Core Extension which allows students to be grouped with similar giftedness students to challenge them in that area.
Programming and Enrichment Opportunities	Every student gets a choice of a STEM class that rotates quarterly. We also offer co-curricular activities including: Jazz Band, Pops Orchestra, Acapella and other extra music offerings. Clubs including Chess, Geography, Robotics, Art, Writing, Science Olympiad, Plains to the Park, WTV-Westview Student News, Coding, National Junior Honor Society (NJHS), Python, Math Club, Drama, Newspaper, yearbook, design challenges and Environmental club
Social Emotional Support	At Westview, students can participate in Team Time 2x a week, Mindset Monday and Student/Teacher progression. We also have a full-time interventionist. Students also participate in a Challenge Day to work on team building.
School Focus	Westview is a <u>STEM focus</u> school dedicated to teaching the whole child. Known for high achievement, Westview has been recognized as a "School to Watch" in 2015 and 2020, and as an <u>Apple Distinguished Schoo</u> l in 2016.
