RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Education approve a contract with OPG-3, Inc., for a Laserfiche Enterprise Content Management Solution and further authorize Greg Fieth, Chief Financial Officer, to sign all necessary documents.

BACKGROUND:

Purchasing, Finance and District Technology Services Departments issued Request for Proposal (RFP) 2023-033 for an Enterprise Content Management Solution on January 23, 2023. Fifteen (15) responses were received on March 7, 2023. Responses were evaluated and the top four (4) firms were selected to participate in a product demonstration and interview process.

As a result of this process and further negotiation, it was determined that OPG-3, Inc provided the most advantageous solution to the District.

To align this contract with the district's fiscal year, the cost to the District for the initial term October 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025, will be \$300,122.22 for software licensing, professional services, training and support. Annual software licensing and on-going support for years two (2) through five (5) are estimated to not exceed \$180,000.00 each year.

Enterprise Content Management (ECM) is a systematic approach to managing content throughout its lifecycle. It enables information - such as Word documents, PDFs, emails and scanned images - to be securely stored, categorized, archived, and made accessible to authorized users. This solution allows for consistency in how records and other critical data such as contracts are maintained and accessed. It will also improve district-wide collaboration and content management with a unified platform.

This Change Order includes the cost of providing electrical service to the football field and main gymnasium scoreboards at Erie High School.

Funding for the project comes from Capital funds. This item is being brought forth to comply with Board policy FEH stating any items over \$99,999 must have Board approval.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Education approves the accreditation recommendations for schools within the St. Vrain Valley School District.

BACKGROUND

The District Accountability/Accreditation Committee is made up of parents and community members, an elementary principal, a secondary principal, and a teacher. Jamie Ball works with the Committee as the liaison from St. Vrain. The Committee met on August 30, 2023, to review the performance of the St. Vrain Schools. As a result of the meeting, the Committee recommends the following accreditation status for schools.

The Committee follows the guidelines of SB 09-163 to recommend accreditation levels for schools and uses the Colorado Department of Education's (CDE) School Performance Frameworks to identify accreditation levels of schools. The framework considers the following data areas to determine school accreditation levels: Academic Achievement, Academic Growth, and Postsecondary and Workforce Readiness. St. Vrain Virtual High School and New Meridian High School are CDE approved alternative campuses and use different assessment data for the framework calculations.

The Committee recommends District Learning Services' personnel meet with schools that are accredited with an improvement, priority improvement, or turnaround plan. At those meetings, schools are asked to answer questions about their current performance, plans to improve that performance, for any additional data that the school might have collected, and what support needs to be provided by the District. The Committee also may request to meet with schools and/or District Learning Services to discuss school improvement plans.
